

# LUDOVIC BOURCE

## BIOGRAPHY

Ludovic Bource is an Academy Award-winning composer. His score for *The Artist*, recorded with the award-winning Brussels Philharmonic, elevated Bource to international fame and earned him numerous accolades, including an Academy Award, a Golden Globe Award, a Grammy Award, and a BAFTA Award. He is also known for his Emmy-nominated score for HBO's Larry David-directed film, *Clear History*.

Bource began his career composing music for commercials, but later moved on to short films, such as *En attendant*, *Spartacus*, and *Sirene Song*. After working on the Michel Hazanavicius film *Mes amis*, Bource has become a long-time collaborator with the director. He has since scored such Hazanavicius films as *OSS 117: Cairo*, *Nest of Spies*, its sequel *OSS 117: Lost in Rio*, and the acclaimed black-and-white silent film *The Artist*. He was invited to join the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences in June 2012 and was also named a Chevalier des Arts et Lettres by the French Government.
